SC Envirothon is an environmental education competition run by the South Carolina Department of Natural Resources. High school students from across the state come together to compete for scholarships by taking hands-on exams over topics like **soils, aquatics, forestry, wildlife and current environmental issues** while achieving goals set forth by the state curriculum standards. The program motivates students to become action oriented, environmentally aware adults. State winners receive a sponsorship to represent South Carolina Envirothon at the annual National Conservation Foundation Envirothon Competition. The Envirothon program influences over 500,000 students across the nation each year!

Our mission is to advance environmental awareness through an outdoor venue for high school students to assess their knowledge of natural resource management issues and to promote a **life-long commitment to environmental stewardship**.

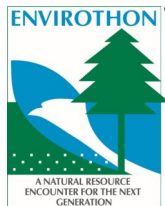
